



BONNEY LAKE, WA July 12, 2008 — Shon Valland returned to Grays Harbor Raceway on Saturday night guiding his machine to another top 10 finish in the Ford Focus Midget A Main feature race.

Shon, piloting the Valland Motorsports #8x midget sponsored by Wired Energy Drinks, EC Computers, Simpson, Super Shox and King Street Bar & Oven scored a third place finish in the evening's trophy dash. He then started the 20-lap feature race on the outside of the front row before finishing sixth at the 3/8-mile, high-banked oval in Elma, WA.

This continues a run of five straight top-10 finishes for the team for the 2008 season.

Currently Valland Motorsports has 684 points which puts the team in third place in the Grays Harbor Raceway Ford Focus Midget season's championship point standings, 20 points back from the second place driver Lee St. Paul and 42 points back from series leader Jeff Bell.

"All we need is a few strong finishes and we will be right there in the championship hunt for the season.", said Shon Valland. "We are looking forward to the remaining events for 2008, as well as our exhibition race at Skagit Speedway on August 16<sup>th</sup>.

The Valland Motorsports team will return to action at Grays Harbor Raceway in Elma, WA on July 26<sup>th</sup>.
